We are a friendly, supportive community of families who have children or young people with special needs or a disability that live in the borough of Harrow.

Our steering group is made up of parents that have children or young people with SEN/disability. We volunteer our own time to work on behalf of local families, helping to shape local services and ensuring the views of parents are passed on to professionals from the departments of Education, Social Care and Health. We represent the parents of children and young people with any form of SEND or health needs, both pre and post diagnosis, up to the age of 25, including those in mainstream schools.

Here are some of the things we do:

- Organise coffee mornings/evenings and other events
- Hold coffee mornings in schools (special schools, mainstream, nurseries)

- Provide parents with information
- Signpost parents to local and national support agencies and organisations
- Provide information on the Harrow Local Offer and how to access services
- Help encourage parents to maintain their own wellbeing
